

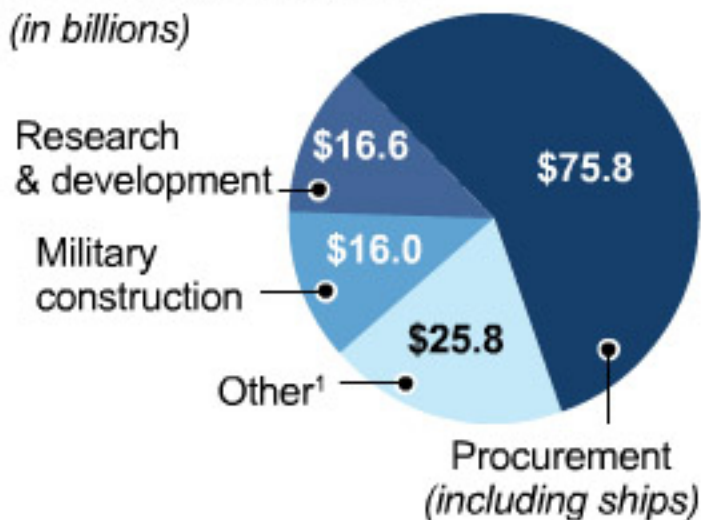
A Closer Look at Unobligated Defense Funds

Fiscal 2011 ended with about \$134.2 billion in defense funds not on contract, mostly in categories with high levels of defense contractor spending. The Office of Management and Budget estimates that \$83.5 billion will remain unobligated on Sept. 30, 2012, the end of the fiscal year. Amounts not put on contract by Jan. 2, 2013, will be subject to sequestration.
